

I, Emma Kalleonalani of
Honolulu, Island of Oahu, Hawaiian Islands
Dowager Queen of said Hawaiian Islands
being of sound and disposing mind and
memory do make publish and declare this
my last will and testament, hereby revoking
all former wills by me at any time heretofore
made

Item. I hereby nominate and
appoint Alexander J. Cartwright of
said Honolulu to be executor and trustee of
this my last will and request that he
shall be exempt from giving any bond
either as executor or trustee.

Item. I do direct and my will is
that all my just debts and funeral ex-
penses shall be paid by my said executor
as soon after my decease as shall be found
convenient.

Item. I give and bequeath to my
servants Kekii, Mamaina and Kulini
absolutely One hundred Dollars each.

Item. I give and bequeath to Jennie
Stillman, Katie Montgomery and
Sarah Weed all of said Honolulu ab-
solutely Three hundred Dollars each.

Item. I give and bequeath all my
books and pamphlets to the Honolulu
Library and Reading Room Association
absolutely.

Item. I give and devise to Elizabeth
K. Pratt wife of Frank S. Pratt of our

Honolulu her heirs and assigns those two certain tracts of land situate at Mālikī in said Island of Oahu and known as $\frac{1}{2}$ Polohi Aina and described in Royal Patent N° 6715, L. C. Award N° 11 to Keawehano.

To have and to hold to her the said Elizabeth H. Pratt and her heirs and assigns forever.

Item. I give and devise to Mary Lewi of said Honolulu and her heirs and assigns forever the Ihi aina of Kalaepohaku, Hamoiliili, Waikiki in said Island of Oahu being the same premises described in Royal Patent N° 7169, L. C. Award N° 6400 to Kapu.

Item. I give and devise to Lucy Kalanikiekie Davis of said Honolulu and her heirs and assigns forever all that certain house lot situate on the mauka side of Bellanca Street near Emma Street in said Honolulu

Item. I give and devise to Grace Kahoolii of said Honolulu and her heirs and assigns the following lands situate in the said Hawaiian Islands, viz: 1st The Ahupuaa of Papaakoko, situate in Koolauloa in said Island of Oahu and being the same premises described in Royal Patent N° 5590 to Kauhola. 2nd That certain house lot situate on the East side of Uluauhae Street between Bertram and Motel Streets in said Honolulu being the same premises that were devised to me by Kauhola by her last will and that are now occupied by Kamaheli. 3rd All the land from

as Kahanaiki situate in Kailua, Koolau-pohoa in said Island of Oahu being Apiana 1 of Royal Patent No 3623, L. C. Award No 6100 to Moolau. To have and to hold all and singular the above described premises with the appurtenances to the said Grace Ka-hoalii and her heirs and assigns forever to her sole and separate use free from the interference, control, disposal, debts and liabilities of any husband she may have.

Item. I give and devise to Stella Ke-mailani of said Honolulu and her heirs and assigns the following tracts or parcels of land situate in said Hawaiian Islands.
1st. That tract or parcel of land situate in Nuuanu Valley and known as Kaala-luna and described in Royal Patent No 4371, L. C. Award No 7260 to D. Namakeha. 2nd. All that certain house lot known as Pukaeawale situate on the makai side of Queen Street next to the corner of Alakea Street in said Honolulu and devised to me by Namakeha by his last will.
3rd. That certain Kalo patch situate at Lahaina in the Island of Maui known as Kainone and described in L. C. Award No 7260. To have and to hold all and singular the above described premises with the appurtenances to the said Stella Ke-mailani and her heirs and assigns forever to her sole and separate use free from the interference, control, disposal, debts and liabilities of any husband she may have.

Item. It is my will and I do direct my

said trustee or his successor to give to Hikoni^m
of said Honolulu the privilege of residing
upon the premises now occupied by her on
Maunaheka Street in said Honolulu or the
land reserved in the lease of Lawaii in the
Island of Kauai during her natural life as
she shall elect without payment of rent for
the use of the same and to John Blossom
and Louis of said Honolulu the privilege of
residing upon the premises known as Hilo-
hana situated at Nuuanu Valley in said Island
of Oahu for and during their natural lives
and the life of the survivor of them without
payment of rent for the use of the same.

Item. I give and bequeath to the several
persons next hereinafter named for their
respective lives the several annuities which
follow their respective names, to wit: To Lucy
nly of said Honolulu Nine hundred
Dollars per annum. To the said Hikoni^m
Six hundred Dollars per annum. To the said
Grace Kahoalii Three hundred Dollars per
annum for her sole and separate use inde-
pendently of any husband she may have and
her receipt to be a sufficient discharge to my
said trustee for the same. To the said Mary
Lewai Three hundred Dollars per annum.
And I direct such annuities to be paid by
my said trustee or his successors in regular
monthly payments.

Item. I give and bequeath to St An-
drews Priory of said Honolulu the sum

of Six hundred Dollars per annum to be applied towards the maintenance of four yearly scholarships of One hundred and fifty Dollars each to be called Queen Emma Scholarships. And I direct my said trustee or his successors to pay to the head Sister for the time being of said St Andrews Priory said sum of Six hundred Dollars yearly for said Scholarships, the said sisters receipt to be a sufficient discharge to my said trustee or his successors for the same.

Item. I give devise and bequeath to the said Alexander J. Cartwright and his heirs and assigns the following tracts pieces or parcels of land situate in the said Islands of Kauai and Oahu, viz: 1st. The Ahupuaa of Lawai situate at Puna in the said Island of Kauai and described in Royal Patent N° 44512 to James Young Hanchoa. 2nd. That certain house and premises situate in said Nuuanu Valley in said Island of Oahu and known as Manaiakamalama and described in Royal Patent N° 97. 3rd. That certain premises situate on Richards, Queen and Alakea Streets in said Honolulu and known as Huelhue and described in Royal Patent N° 6708 to Kamehameha III and Royal Patent N° 5729 to Kaumokuha. 4th. That certain residence and premises situate at Waikiki in said Island of Oahu known as Kalua o Kau and described in L.C. Award N° 8559 to W.C. Lumalilo. 5th. The land of Alahunui and

Aa situate in Kaneohe in said Island of Oahu being the same premises that were conveyed to me by Kahu. 6th That certain premises situate on Maunakea Street near King Street in said Honolulu and described in Royal Patent N° 2647 to J. Hale. ~~~
7th. The one undivided half of the Apana of Malawa situate in the District of Ewa in said Island of Oahu described in Royal Patent N° 6717 to Grace Kamaihi, but in trust nevertheless to devote the rents income and profits thereof to the payment of the aforesaid annuities and scholarships. Upon the death of said annuitants then my said trustee or his successor may sell any one or more of the aforesaid pieces of real estate free and discharged of any trust provided the real estate remaining will produce a yearly income sufficient to provide for the aforesaid scholarships. The proceeds derived from the sale of any lands as aforesaid to be divided one half to The Queen's Hospital a corporation existing under the laws of the said Hawaiian Islands and its successors and assigns forever, the remaining half to the said Alexander J. Cartwright and his heirs and assigns but in trust nevertheless to invest the same and the income to pay to my cousin Albert H. Kuniaakea of said Honolulu during his life and upon the death of said Albert H. Kuniaakea to pay the

principal sum so invested to the lawful issue of the body of said Albert. K. Kumuiakea living at his decease, children of deceased child to take by right of representation their parents share. Any surplus rents income or profit derived from said real estate after the payment of said annuities and scholarships to be divided as follows one half to The Queens Hospital aforesaid and its successors and assigns and one half to said Alexander. J. Cartwright but in trust to pay the same to the said Albert. K. Kumuiakea for life and upon his death to pay said surplus to the lawful issue of the body of said Albert. K. Kumuiakea living at his decease, children of deceased child to take by right of representation their parents share. After the death of all said annuitants if for any reason it should be deemed advisable in the discretion of my said trustee to sell the remainder of said real estate herein before charged with the payment of said scholarships. I hereby empower my said trustee or his successor with authority to sell said remaining land or lands free and discharged from any trust and the proceeds thereof to invest in safe and sound property holding said property charged with the same trust as aforesaid to pay over the income for the purpose of maintaining said scholarships rendering the surplus income

as aforesaid one half to The Queen's Hospital aforesaid and one half in trust for the said Albert K. Kūnuiakaha during his life and upon his death to those who are the lawful issue of his body living at his decease, children taking by right of representation their parents share.

Item. I give and devise to The Queen's Hospital aforesaid and its successors and assigns forever the following tracts, pieces or parcels of land, viz.: 1st The premises situate on Fort and Union Streets in said Honolulu known as the French Hotel premises and described in Royal Patent N° 653 to T. C. B. Rooke. 2nd The premises situate on the corner of Beretania and Nuuanu Streets in said Honolulu described in Royal Patent N° 83 to T. C. B. Rooke. 3rd All those two pieces of land at Monukaha at the head of Queen Street in said Honolulu and described in L. C. Award N° 677 and conveyed by W. C. Parke as Marshal to T. C. B. Rooke. 4th Land of Hopenui at Puunui on the south side of Leileha Street in said Honolulu portion of Royal Patent N° 607 to T. C. B. Rooke. 5th Land at Kaaipee in said Puunui being a portion of Royal Patent N° 607 to T. C. B. Rooke. 6th Land of Luapaldo in said Puunui described in Royal Patent N° 606 to T. C. B. Rooke. 7th Land situated at Niolopa in said Nuuanu Valley and described in Royal Patent N° 606 to T. C.

B. Rooke. 8th. Land of Waolani in said
Nuuanu known as Rooke's Valley and de-
scribed in Royal Patent N° 168 to T. C. B.
Rooke. 9th. The rest residue and remainder of
the lands of Pohaku and Maulo situated in the
Island of Maui and described in Royal Patent N°
538 to Koahou.

Item. I give and devise to the said
Alexander J. Cartwright his heirs and
assigns the following tract's pieces or parcels
of land situated in the said Hawaiian Is-
lands, viz: 1st The Ahupuaa of Kawaihae
situate in Kohala in the Island of Hawaii
and described in Royal Patent N° 1666, L. C.
Award N° 8515 to Keoni Ana. 2nd The
Ahupuaa of Healahewa situate in said
Kohala and described in Royal Patent N°
1665, L. C. Award N° 8515 B to Kaaanacha.
3rd The Ahupuaa of Waikahekake situate
in Puna in said Island of Hawaii. 4th The
Ahupuaa of Hamoamoa situated in said
Puna and described in Royal Patent N° 1665
L. C. Award N° 8515 B to Kaaanacha. ~
5th The land of Halakaa situate in said
Lahaina and described in Royal Patent N°
6727, L. C. Award N° 8520 to Joshua Haco,
but in trust nevertheless as follows: during
the natural life of my said cousin Albert
H. Kunuiakia to pay over to him the
net rents and profits thereof and at his
death to convey said premises to the lawful
issue of the body of said Albert. H. Kunui-

at his living at his decease, children taking by right of representation their parents share. To have and to hold to them their heirs and assigns forever. But my said trustee or his successors may in his or their discretion upon the request in writing of the said Albert H. Kūnūikēa during his life sell and convey in fee all and singular the said premises free from the trusts hereby created holding the proceeds of such sale upon the same trusts as are herein before expressed regarding the said premises.

Item. I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my property and estate, real personal and mixed of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which I shall be entitled or have any right and claim at the time of my decease one half to The Queens Hospital aforesaid and its successors and assigns forever and one half to the said Alexander J. Cartwright his heirs and assigns in trust nevertheless for the following purposes, viz: To hold the same in trust to take charge of and manage the same with full power to him to sell all or any portion of said property and estate and reinvest the proceeds of the same in his discretion and pay over the net rents interest income and profits of said property and estate to the said Albert H. Kūnūikēa during his natural life and at his death to convey the said premises property and estate to those who may be the lawful issue of the body of said Albert H. Kūnūikēa living at his decease

children to take by right of representation
their parents share; To have and to hold unto them
their heirs and assigns forever. But if the
said Albert H. Kūnuiākea should die with-
out leaving lawful issue living at his decease
then I give, devise and bequeath all the said
half of said rest residue and remainder of my
said property and estate and all the said prop-
erty hereinbefore devised and bequeathed to the
issue of said Albert H. Kūnuiākea living at
his decease to The Queens Hospital afore-
said and its successors and assigns forever
