Liliuokalani, by the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands. To all who shall see these Presents, Greeting: Know Ye, that reposing special confidence in the wisdom, integrity and fidelity of Eugene Borel, Knight Companion of the Royal Order of the Crown of Hawaii, We have appointed and do hereby constitute and commission him to be Our Delegate and Commissioner to the Congress of the Universal Postal Union to be held in the City of Vienna, and We do authorize and empower him to have and to hold the said office, and to exercise and enjoy all the rights, pre-eminences, privileges and authorities to the same of right appertaining during Our pleasure. And We do hereby pray and request the Government of His Imperial Majesty the Emperor of Austria and Apostolic King of Hungary and all the Authorities and Officers thereof to permit the said Eugene Borel fully and peaceably to enjoy and exercise the said office with all the rights privileges and immunities to the same appertaining without giving or suffering to be given unto him any molestation or trouble, but on the contrary to afford him all proper countenance and assistance, We offering to do the same for all those who shall in like manner be recommended to Us by the said Government of His Imperial and Apostolic Majesty. In testimony whereof We have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Kingdom to be hereunto affixed. Given under Our hand at Our Palace of Iolani in the City of Honolulu this twentieth day of March A. D. 1891 and in the first year of Our Reign.
