

Proclamation


Whereas, customary international law recognizes that archipelagic States may exercise sovereignty and jurisdiction over their territorial seas; and

Whereas, the territorial sea of the Hawaiian Kingdom is a maritime zone extending beyond the land territory of the Hawaiian Kingdom over which the Hawaiian Kingdom exercises sovereignty and jurisdiction, a sovereignty and jurisdiction that extends to the airspace over the territorial sea:


Now, therefore, We, the acting Council of Regency of the Hawaiian Kingdom, serving in the absence of the Monarch and temporarily exercising the Royal Power of the Kingdom, we do hereby declare, proclaim, and make known the extension of the territorial sea of the Hawaiian Kingdom to be 12 nautical miles from the baselines of the Hawaiian Kingdom determined in accordance with customary international law.




In Witness Whereof, We have hereunto set our hand, and caused the Great Seal of the Kingdom to be affixed this 16th day of September A.D. 2013.




